The Mead Family Foundation is proud to report on its grants from 2012. Grants went primarily to organizations working in K-12 academic education, arts education, strengthening families and crisis prevention. 2012 also marked a continuation of the Healthy Eating, Healthy Lifestyles Youth initiative, a program that promotes healthy eating and healthy lifestyles for youth in Maryland. The Foundation deepened its knowledge of new geographies (North Carolina) and support for key nonprofits that have been community anchors over the past few years.

Through good economic cycles and bad, the Foundation has supported the leadership and programs of hundreds of area non-profits. This year has been no exception. By the end of 2012, the Foundation extended over \$740,000 dollars in grants to 51 non-profit organizations in Maryland, North Carolina and Washington D.C.
