The Mead Family Foundation is proud to report on its grants from 2013. Grants went primarily to organizations in Maryland and North Carolina working in K-12 academic education, arts education, strengthening families and crisis prevention. 2013 also marked a continuation of the Healthy Eating, Healthy Lifestyles Youth initiative, a program that promotes healthy eating and healthy lifestyles for youth. While some grants were restricted to program support, the majority of the grants in 2013 were strategically awarded as general operating support to outstanding mission-aligned nonprofit organizations. The Foundation continues to support the leadership and programs of hundreds of nonprofit organizations through several capacity building grants.
